- All swine and sheep must be stalled by 7:00 a.m. and beef by 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 27 if showing on Saturday. If just showing on Sunday swine and sheep must be stalled by 7:00 a.m. and beef by 9:00 a.m. on Sunday, August 28.
- Entry Fees for swine and sheep are \$10 per head per day.
- Entry Fees for beef are \$20 per head per day.
- Entry Deadline: Postmarked on or before August 20, 2011. If postmarked after August 20th entry fees will be doubled.
- There will be no classes for Rams, Bulls, Boars, and Cow/Calf Pairs.
- Market animals that will only be exhibited on Sunday will be weighed on Sunday. All others will use the same weight from Saturday's weigh-in.

Ransom County Junior Point Show Guidelines

Show committee will follow rules and guidelines set forth by the North Dakota Junior Points Show Association. Shows are open to any youth who have not turned 21 as of October 1, 2010.

Complete entry forms must be postmarked by August 20, 2011. Entries postmarked after August 20 will be charged double entry fee. The 2011 Ransom County Fair Junior Point Show Entry Form is available at: www.ransomcountyfair.com/FairJrPoint.htm.

Entry fees are as follows:

Beef

\$20 per animal per day

Swine & Sheep

\$10 per animal per day

Entry fees are non refundable.

Signature on the Entry Form shall be deemed acceptance of the rules for the Ransom County Fair as well as abiding by the IAFE (International Association of Fairs & Expositions) National Code of Show Ring Ethics as stated on the Ransom County Fair Website.

All animals must be visibly free of infectious diseases. This includes ring worm, lump jaw, warts and show lamb fungus in active stages.

A veterinarian will be present to inspect animals.

Out of state animals must present health certificates to show management upon arrival.

LIVESTOCK ENTRY

Stalls and wash rack will be available after 7:00 p.m. on Friday, August 26.

Swine & Sheep entry is 7:00 -7:30 a.m. Saturday, August 27, between the Cattle and Swine barns. Swine and sheep must be on the grounds by 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 27.

Beef must be on the grounds and checked in by 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 28.

If a problem arises with a registered animal the exhibitor will need to furnish registration papers at that time to show officials. If registration papers cannot be furnished in a timely manner for the animal in question it will be moved to the commercial class or disqualified from the show.

Weigh-in of swine and sheep will begin at 7:30 a.m. and steers will be weighed at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 27. Livestock will not be re-weighed for Sunday's show. Only market animals showing on Sunday will be weighed Sunday morning.

LIVESTOCK SHOW SCHEDULE

Saturday, August 27: Swine show will start at 10:00 a.m. with sheep to follow. The beef show will start at 12:30 p.m. or after the conclusion of the sheep show whichever is later.

Sunday, August 28: Swine show will start at 8:30 a.m. with the sheep to follow and the beef will follow the sheep show.

BEDDING

If you stall cattle in the main Cattle Barn you will be charged \$5 per animal for the wood chips provided. Wood chips will be available for purchase at the fairgrounds for \$6 per bag.

Straw is not allowed in the barns. You will be responsible for your own straw in the tie outs.

RELEASE TIME

Release time will be 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 28 for those leaving after the show on Saturday. Those staying for the Sunday show will be allowed to leave following the conclusion of the Beef show.

Stalls must be cleaned and inspected by a member of the show committee before premium checks will be issued.

Exhibitors leaving prior to the established release time or leaving their stalls un-cleaned will forfeit their premium.
